The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, New Orleans District, is continuing its series of public meetings to discuss the progress on the hurricane protection system and status of the environmental compliance efforts. An open house with Corps project staff available to discuss projects one on one will begin at 6 p.m.

Project status presentations start at 7 p.m. with an open discussion period following. The November 29<sup>th</sup> meeting will focus on alternatives for the three outfall canals in Orleans Parish. The December 6th meeting will focus on levee projects for the east bank of St. Charles Parish and along the Jefferson Parish lakefront.
